Thursday, November 14, 2024 ***9:00 AM Shotgun Start***

Please plan your trip to arrive at site at least fifteen minutes before start time and check in with the Tournament Director.

Lunch is being provided after play.
Last year we played here after several years being away for various reasons. The course features long and medium to narrow fairways. The greens tend to be smallish and slower than those at UF. There is plentiful rough that hides your ball if you venture off the fairway. Bunkers are numerous and strategically placed to annoy you. They will test your shot making skills.

The course is a par 72 and we probably will play three tees: White 6092, Red 5342, and Green 4346 yds We will play our usual Medal play format. Note the starting time of 9:00 AM.

UF Golf Club Tournament (10-17-24)

The weather turned chilly last night and provided a chilly and breezy start to our round on Thursday. We had 69 players (we started with 82 Wednesday but had many cancellations). There were no complaints about the temperature. By mid morning the weather was fine.

The UF course always plays tough. The rough along the fairways was especially rough. The best play was to get back on the fairway and forget about advancing the-ball very much. The greens were fast as usual. You should avoid downhill putts but that requires hitting precise approach shots. If you hit short, the ball comes back off the green into the fairway. If you are long the ball goes over to the back of the green. Good luck with those approach shots!

The lunch from Heavenly Ham (boxed sandwich of Ham or Turkey, chips and a cookie) was decent. Lunches are ordered ahead of time so we had to buy extra lunches due to the cancellations. Fortunately we (you) did not have to pay for no shows.

Scores and playing times were reasonable. The course is still a lot of fun to play. Good Job GSGA!

Tribute to Paul Metivier

Paul Metivier, the former President of GSGA for 10 years, retired from this position in January 2024. Paul passed away suddenly earlier this month, under circumstances I don't know or understand. I will pass along any words on family plans as appropriate.

Paul had family problems and some health issues that I believe hastened his retirement, although he found time to continue playing in our tournaments during parts of 2024. He loved to play golf and even owned a golf course.

Paul provided leadership and direction during the difficult times requiring raising fees to play or maintain membership in GSGA. Later, with the threat of covid that required certain cart pairings and playing procedures to be adopted, Paul was instrumental in seeing that GSGA adapted to these changes. Paul helped in instituting player choices for teams in the covid days and that has turned into a fun way to schedule play.

Paul was a good and talented golfer. He was friendly and fun to play with. He was very knowledgeable on the rules of golf, played within the rules, and insisted you also play by the rules. I usually played with Paul and I never regretted those opportunities.

GSGA is eternally grateful for the leadership, guidance, adaptability, and participation that Paul provided during his reign as President of GSGA. To honor Paul's service to GSGA the current Board will name this tournament as the Paul Metivier Memorial Tournament.

Rest in Peace Paul, we will surely miss you.
